Prec(ar)ious Collectives

Palais de Tokyo, Pavillon Neuflyze OBC (Palais de Tokyo's artist-in-residence program) and Fluxum Foundation/Flux Laboratory present a visual arts/dance project curated by Fabien Danesi and choreographed by Andonis Foniadakis in parallel to the documenta 14 art exhibition, which this year is taking place in the Greek capital as well as its traditional home, Kassel in Germany. In collaboration with six dancers currently in residence at Pavillon Neuflyze OBC, eight contemporary Greek choreographers question the notion of community as a situation and not as a subject to illustrate. The location of this hybrid contemporary project, which is being held with the support of the Swiss Embassy in Athens, is a historic building at 23 Academias Street, where the public are invited to walk around the building to get a feel of its architectural aspects.
