### MISSION

Founded in 2003, Flux Laboratory is an experimentation non-profit lab based in Geneva, working closely with Fluxum Foundation ([link support](#)).

Since 2016, Flux Laboratory Athens supports and produces transdisciplinary artistic projects and experiments with new creative and collaborative processes in Greece.

Its mission is to support programs and institutions that enrich the quality of the artistic scene in Greece, with a particular focus on initiatives related to the Body. The Body is approached from the angle of a medium of creation and expression, of social fabric and community, and as an instrument for entrepreneurial and innovative initiatives.

Exchanges:

We support organizations through their programs while curating and funding a specific project.

## FUNDING LIMITATIONS

Funding is limited to areas described in our Guidelines. Flux Laboratory Athens gives priority to Body and community themed projects. We provide support to Greece based projects.

Flux Laboratory Athens supports small and medium scale productions.
